GENERAL INFORMATION

Invitation:

Please note that only UK members are invited to attend the Jalsa Salana UK this year. This decision is taken in line with the guidelines on COVID 19.

All others are requested to join virtually or through MTA.

Hospitality Period:

The hospitality period will be for 5 days which also includes 3 days period of Jalsa.

REGISTRATION

Jalsa Registration Office at Baitul Futuh Mosque will operate from 30/07/2021 from 11:00AM till Isha prayer.

Access to Jalsa Salana Arena:

UK members must have their AIMS Cards to enter Jalsa Salana arena. Those requiring AIMS Cards should contact their local Presidents immediately.

Replacement AIMS Card will be issued if verified by the local President at a charge of £5.00. Please note that there are no arrangements to get AIMS Card issued at Hadeeqatul Mahdi.

Important Note:

AIMS card must be displayed prominently during Jalsa Salana and upon entry to Fazl Mosque, Baitul Futuh Mosque, Islamabad or Baitul Ehsan , at all times جزاكم الله تعالى

RECEPTION & DEPARTURE

Please note that transport & reception arrangements are not available this year. This is because the Jalsa this year is limited to UK members only.

TRANSPORT POLICY

The Jalsa site, Hadeeqatul Mahdi, is located in the suburban area where frequency of vehicular traffic is narrow. The members are requested to use public transport where possible to avoid traffic congestion.

Travel Options:

Alton Railway Station to Hadeeqatul Mahdi under Jama'at Arranged Transport

Hadeeqatul Mahdi is three miles away from National Rail Station, Alton. Shuttle service will run regularly between Alton Station & Hadeeqatul Mahdi during the three days of Jalsa Salana.

Baitul Futuh Mosque to Alton Railway Station by Public Transport

Please take bus number 93 heading Putney Bridge from **Morden South Station** stop. Leave the bus at **Wimbledon Station** bus stop. Take National Rail for Alton Station from Wimbledon Station.

Fazl Mosque to Alton Railway Station by Public Transport

From Fazl Mosque, reach **Southfields Underground Station** by taking route mentioned above (Southfields Station to Fazl Mosque). Take Underground rail for Wimbledon Station and then board National Rail for Alton.

TRANSPORT POLICY

Hadeeqatul Mahdi by Personal Transport:

Members travelling through personal transport should take care of following.

- * This time, all car parking will be accommodated at Hadeeqatul Mahdi though prominent display of Car Pass is mandatory, as always.
- * Temporary parking/transit will be available at Country Market Car Park for **Rapid Lateral Flow Test**, being **mandatory requirement** prior to heading towards Hadeeqatul Mahdi.
- * The Jama'at have agreed plans with the Local Council , Police and Highway Authorities to control cars arriving at and leaving from Hadeeqatul Mahdi during Jalsa Salana. It is very important that Jama'at members comply with these rules, follow driving regulations including speed limit , at all times. Failure to do so will result in damaging the good reputation of Jama'at and may jeopardize the holding of Jalsa Salana at Hadeeqatul Mahdi .
- * During journey, be considerate to other road users and observe exemplary patience in the event of any untoward incident.
- * Parking or driving the vehicle within the premises of Jama'at is at your own risk and as such, Jama'at accepts no liability for any loss of the belongings or damage to your car since safeguarding is always down to the owner.
- * The speed limit on these roads is 30-40 miles per hour (48-64 kilometers per hour. Members should seek guidance from the respective organisations for insurance including breakdown covers and must possess their driving licence.

Signage on highways/roads for Jalsa Salana

Special yellow design signage “**Jalsa Salana**” will be well visible when the guests approach near to Hadeeqatul Mahdi. Direction signage for Country Market Car Park is also there.

TRANSPORT POLICY

Car Parking for Disabled

Limited space of parking is allocated at Hadeeqatul Mahdi Car Park for disabled members of the Jama'at who can apply to avail the facility.

All applications must be made through your Jama'at President and submitted positively on or before 10th July 2021.

Following information is necessary along with above application.

- * Application must have details like name, AIMS ID, Car Registration Number and Mobile Number of the disabled person.
- * Proof of disability such as Valid Disable Badge (Blue Badge) from respective Council or GP/Doctor.
- * Car Pass will be issued in the name of Disabled member.

ACCOMMODATION

Please note that no accommodation can be made available this year to the guests attending Jalsa Salana at Hadeeqatul Mahdi due to current Coronavirus Pandemic situation.

Hotel Accommodation:

Guests who intend to stay in the hotels are requested to book hotel accommodation, on their own. The Jalsa Administration apologizes for not being able to arrange reservation of hotel rooms on behalf of any guest.

MEAL/BAZAAR

Meals:

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner and Tea will be provided from the Langar of Hadhrat Promised Messiah (May peace be upon him) to the guests at Hadeeqatul Mahdi.

Bazaar:

Bazar will not be set up this year.

Milk for Infants:

Milk for infants will be provided under the supervision of

Nazima-e-Aala (Ladies Section), Jalsa Salana UK.

MISCELLANEOUS GUIDELINES

First Aid/Medical Facilities:

During "Hospitality Period", volunteer doctors will be available at Hadeeqatul Mahdi during Jalsa Days. The timings will be displayed outside the dispensaries. Medical treatment for minor ailments will be provided free of charge. If, however, hospital care is needed, guests will be required to contact hospital or A&E as per individual condition.

Amanat, Lost & Found Property Office:

If anyone find and/or misplace personal belongings including money, please report to the Amanat, Lost & Found Property Office.

Safety of Children:

In order to protect minors or young children from getting lost at Hadeeqatul Mahdi, it is advised that necessary information (name, father's name, Jama'at name) should be tied to their wrist or worn around their neck, in English/Urdu. The information can be enclosed in a plastic cover to protect it from the rain.

Laundry:

Laundry facilities will not be available at Hadeeqatul Mahdi (Oaklands Farm).

Pedestrian Movement outside Hadeeqatul Mahdi:

Roads/streets outside Hadeeqatul Mahdi (Oaklands Farm) are narrow as well as without street lights and often deserted. Guests are advised to drive carefully and avoid going alone on foot. In case of an emergency, please keep a small torch with you, if so required.

MISCELLANEOUS GUIDELINES

Cleanliness:

Please help us keep Hadeeqatul Mahdi, just clean. Litter bins are placed at various points for this purpose. Ensure implementation of the practice by your minors.

On Site Rules for Drivers

The following rules apply to all drivers, whether employees, volunteers, contractors, visitors, participants or any other driver, of any vehicle, including cars, vans, lorries, fork lift trucks, tractors, all terrain vehicles, any other lifting vehicle.

- All drivers must follow the on site speed limit of 5 mph at all times
- All drivers must give priority to pedestrians, particularly at pedestrian crossings
- All drivers must give way to larger vehicles, particularly on narrow stretches and bends
- Using a mobile phone while driving is strictly prohibited
- Drivers of fork lift trucks must have carried out training accredited by the Health and Safety Executive and drive safely
- Drivers of other service vehicles must be competent and drive safely
- Keys must not be left in any vehicle, such as fork lift trucks
- Drivers should not park on the main roadways and trackways, as this causes obstruction, but can park adjacent to these
- Large vehicles that need to reverse must use a banksman who is visible to the driver a high visibility vest should be worn by the banksman
- Vehicles must not be driven with passengers riding on the side or back of vehicles, e.g. on the side of the cab of tractors, in the rear of vans or lorries, at the back of all terrain vehicles or electric buggies

Please note that failure to comply with the above rules may result in disciplinary action by the Jamaat. The Jamaat, workers, including volunteers, contractors, participants and visitors all have legal health and safety responsibilities and failure to comply may lead to legal action by the local authority.
